Ken Bennett is a politician and businessman who has served as President of the Arizona Senate. In the 1980's, Bennett was a member of the Prescott City Council. He was elected to the Arizona State Board of Education in 1992, serving as President in 1996 and 1998.

In 1998 he was elected to the Arizona State Senate, where he served as President and sat on the Rules Committee. After eight years in the State Senate, he was prevented from seeking re-election in 2006 because of term limits. He abandoned a run for governor in 2006, but has said that he will run for statewide or federal office in the future. His topic will be the budget for Arizona for 2008.
